Devotional History of Adhoksaja Das

Adhoksaja das was born on the 16th of May 1975 in Serpukhov, Moscow Region, Russia. Attracted and inspired by sankirtana devotees Adhoksaja das joined the temple in February of 1993. In 1995 he was initiated by Harikesa Swami. In 2000 he was re-initiated and given a brahminical initiation by Niranjana Swami.

Book distribution was always the main source of inspiration and the main activity i He was very inspired to see how Srila Prabhupada's books change people's lives. In families that had bought books from him. They became devotees, started to chant t regulative principles. Adhoksaja held training programs for them, gave classes, tau etiquette and was overseeing them in KC. At present all of them are initiated devot

At that time having received support and blessings from the local authorities Adhoksaja for the first time participated in cable TV programs. It was his first preaching in mass media.

By 2000 there was a decline in book distribution in ISKCON worldwide. In summer 2002 Adhoksaja organized Russian Sankirtana Festival with the help of Yasomatinandana Prabhu and Ekanatha Prabhu (who was his first sponsor). At the festival Sankirtana Ministry of CIS (Russia, Ukraine, Belarus) was established to develop book distribution. On Bhakti Vijnana Goswami's and Bhakti Ananta Krishna Goswami's initiative Adhoksaja was included in the executive board of the Sankirtana Ministry.

Also in 2002 with the help of Yasomatinandana Prabhu, Adhoksaja started a new Russian sankirtana magazine entitled New Age Sankirtana. Unlike Param Vijayate Sri Krisna Sankirtanam magazine in the 1990's, this magazine had another task – to propagate new sankirtana programs, to depict new trends in book distribution. The magazine is published up to now.

Since 2002 with the blessings of the local authorities and Bhakti Vijnana Goswami Adhoksaja developed a few sankirtana projects to develop book distribution in Russia.

In 2002 Adhoksaja started an educational program for young devotees. The program took the form of a school where young Vaisnavas were taught Vaisnava philosophy and practice Krishna Consciousness as well as Vaisnava etiquette. Besides, devotees were trained in book distribution. For fourteen years every summer Adhoksaja has been organizing preaching tours to South Russia with 10-25 participants. The tour includes daily book distribution and philosophy studies. During the tour seminars are held daily as well as quizzes and competitions with sweet prizes for the winners. The participants follow regular program of Mangala-arati, Japa, Guru-puja, Bhagavatam class, Kirtanas etc. All this is done while travelling in Russia. The tour usually lasts for 15 days. Within this period devotees cover 4,500-5,000 km. On the way they distribute books in cities of South Russia. They spend nights in tents in the country. Some devotees sleep in a van which was donated to them by Vijaya Prabhu (ISKCON Sankirtana Minister) along with Srila Prabhupada's disciples from the US. For a few days they distribute books on the Black Sea Coast and a few days – in the Caucasus mountains. A few generations of devotees attended the school. Nine of the students received first initiation. Many of the students chant pranama-mantra and are getting ready for the initiation. A few devotees from that program have become leaders.

In 2003 Adhoksaja organised a health program for CIS sankirtana devotees. Every year sankirtana devotees who have health problems come to ISKCON Ershovo health center and get free medical aid.

In 2003 with GBC's approval and blessings Adhoksaja established Social Security Fund for Sankirtana Devotees. Bhakti Vijnana Goswami allowed sankirtana devotees to contribute to the Fund by taking a small percentage from every distributed book which they continue doing still. The Fund has three main activities: 1. Direct monetary aid to sankirtana devotees for medical purposes; 2. Financial support of elderly sankirtana devotees; 3. Maintenance of the Health center. The program has already existed for 13 years. Many sankirtana devotees get financial support for medical purposes.

In 2004 Adhoksaja organized special edition of the sankirtana bulletin called Sankirtana of the 21st Century. It was a colour brochure for free distribution in ISKCON centers. The bulletin was published for 4 years. At present it is out of print. Adhoksaja plans to resume the project.

In 2010 with the blessings of Gopal Krsna Goswami Adhoksaja organized Weekend Sankirtana Program in Nizhny Novgorod and started to launch this program in different cities of Russia. Over 30 Russian temples participate in the program. The scores of Weekend Sankirtana Program increase year after year. In

2014 the program participants distributed about 40,000 books. In 2014 and 2015 Adhoksaja organized Weekend Sankritana festivals.

In 2011 Adhoksaja supervised construction of a preaching and training center. At present there is a regional training center called Naimisaranya.

In 2014 Adhoksaja started a new project called Sundaracala. It is a small community in the country comprising a brahmacari and a vanaprastha asram.

At present Adhoksaja oversees 2 brahmacari asramas in different cities with 10 brahmacaris living in each of them.

Adhoksaja does all these projects along with his main service which is book distribution. He has been distributing books full time every day (except days when he travels from one place to another) for 24 years since 1993.

In 1998-2015 Adhoksaja was no 1 on sankirtana yearly's and Srila Prabhupada marathon's scores in Nizhny Novgorod Region. A few times he was among the top 10 book distributors in the world. In 2011 he was no 6 in the world. Since 1998 he has been in the top 10 book distributors in the CIS.

Since 1998 Adhoksaja has been giving regular Bhagavatam classes in the Golden Ring Region of Russia. Since 2005 up to now he has been giving 270 hours of classes a year. Besides, he regularly travels and gives seminars in other places. A third of his time he spends in Nizhny Novgorod. Another third of his time Adhoksaja delivers subject seminars. Since 2005 he has been giving as many as 10-12 seminars a year. The seminars last 3-7 days. Some of his seminars can be found in his group in the Russian social network called VKONTAKTE (<http://vk.com/adhokshaja>). Since 2000 another third of his time he spends visiting ISKCON centers in different countries such as Russia, Ukraine, Belarus, Lithuania and Kazakhstan.

Adhoksaja was inspired to take this renunciation path by bhakti and renunciation in the hearts of pure devotees in our movement.

He believes that accepting sannyasa will help him to steadily follow this path without turning back and to attain the highest perfection – to please Lord Caitanya and Lord Krsna. He also believes that thus he will have more opportunities to engage new devotees in the preaching mission.



Asim Krishna Das (India) 2 years

I, Asim Krishna Das, was born in Punaw village of Bhabua District, Bihar on 12th November 1965. During my school days I met devotees especially H.H. Radha Govinda Das Goswami Maharaja and then H.H. Gaur Krishna Dasa Goswami Maharaja in 1984. I started actively participating in preaching activities with above devotees along with my college studies. We used to perform Kirtan, distribute Srila Prabhupada's Books and travel in remote villages of Bihar preaching the science of Krishna Consciousness. Getting inspired by H.H. Radha Govinda Dasa Goswami Maharaja I took first initiation from him on 2nd January 1987 in Bihar.

Once in 1989, I went to Sri Vrindavan Dham with H.H. Gaur Krishna Goswami Maharaja and then we travelled to Delhi and Chandigarh for Ratha Yatra. In Chandigarh I met H.G. Devakinandan Prabhu. H.H. Gaur Krishna Das Goswami Maharaja and H.G. Devakinandan Prabhu encouraged me to join Brahmachari Ashram in ISKCON Juhu. So I joined the Sankirtan bus which came from Juhu during the Ratha Yatra time and came to ISKCON Juhu and became a Brahmachari. Then till 1991 I served in Sankirtan Department in ISKCON Juhu.

In Vrindavan, 15 November 1991, I took second initiation from H.H. Radha Govinda Dasa Goswami Maharaja. Then I served as new Bhakta Director for the year 1992. Then from 1992 to 1998 I served in Life Patron Membership Department.

Since 1997, I started giving seminars on Srimad Bhagavatam, Sri Chaitanya Charitamrita in places like Mumbai, Bihar, Uttar Pradesh, Chitrakut, Jharkhand, Pune, Surat, Vapi, Mauritius, Kenya etc. Since 1998 up to 2000 I was serving in Kitchen Department. From 2000 to 2005, I served in New Bhakta Department and then from 2005 to 2015 I was serving as Temple Commander.

Recently ISKCON management has asked me to travel and preach in various parts of India and abroad. Alongside I will also be serving as Brahmachari Council Head in ISKCON Juhu. My base will always be ISKCON Juhu. I feel enthusiastic participating

in Book Distribution and giving seminars on Srimad Bhagavatam and Sri Chaitanya Charitamrita.

Personal example of my Gurudev H.H. Radha Govinda Das Goswami Maharaja and my God Brother H.H. Gaura Krishna Das Goswami Maharaja and also other senior devotees in ISKCON Juhu like Braj Hari Prabhu inspired me on the path of renunciation.

Taking Sannyasa will keep me completely engaged in reading and speaking the glories of Lord Hari.



Bhaktipada Das (SRS) (Hungari/Romania/Turkey) 1 years

I was born 7th November 1969 in Uzsgorod, Ukraine, USSR.

When I was a small child I met the word “death”. I asked my grandfather what does death mean. His reply was: “when you don't exist anymore. I couldn't understand. What does it mean that I don't exist anymore?”

All my life I was searching for answers what is the meaning of death, and whether there's life beyond death. I saw my mother working hard constantly either at her job or at home. I was thinking: “Is this what life is about? Job and household?” I was searching for answers since my childhood: “What is the meaning of life?”

After becoming 15 years old, I became convinced about the existence of God. Whenever I asked Him some help, He always helped. But after He helped me, I forgot about Him and I didn't even say, “Thank You.”

After a while I realized that I have to become more conscientious, and I have to at least say “Thank You” for helping me. Once I had a huge problem. I asked God to help me, but at the same time I felt I had to reciprocate with Him. I told Him, “Please help me, and in turn I will broadcast Your glories everywhere.”

In the '90s, I started to learn more and more about who is God, and whether there's life beyond death. I read lots of books. I learned that He is a person and at the same time He is impersonal. The main thing is that I couldn't put the two together. So I asked God to please give me bonafide knowledge. At that time I was living in Hungary and I came in contact with Srila Prabhupada's books, but I hadn't met the devotees yet. When I read those books I immediately put the whole picture together and I saw that this is perfect and there's no mistake in the books.

When I met the devotees in 1994 they told me that this is a preaching movement and I remembered that I promised God years ago that I will broadcast His glories everywhere. I immediately knew that this is my path. I could hardly wait for the temple president at Budapest to tell me I should move in.

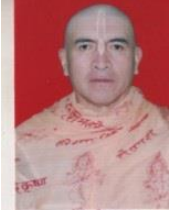
I moved in to the Budapest temple in March 1996. I served as the temple commander. In June 1997 I moved to New Vraja Dhama (Hungary) following the order of Srila Sivarama Maharaja. I got first initiation in May 1998. I received second initiation in January 1999. I served as a temple commander for 4 years in New Vraja Dhama. Then I did pujari service until 2009. Besides that, I was studying a lot, sometimes for 10-12 hours. And I travelled a lot to preach with small Radhe-Syama

utsava Deities. Generally I travelled in Hungary, but sometimes I went to Moscow and to a few towns in Ukraine. It was my favorite service.

I'm preaching in 6 towns in Hungary since 2009. We are building communities there. My base is New Vraja Dhama.

I'm most happy when I'm engaged in preaching activities. I wanted to accept sannyasa as soon as I moved in to the temple. I didn't want to do anything else apart from studying, practicing spiritual life and trying to help others. I was always very enthusiastic for that.

Even now I'm so happy that I don't own a house, I don't have my own car, I don't have anything, so I'm free from all anxieties. If I would receive sannyasa initiation I could be a better help for my spiritual master in spreading Krishna-consciousness. I could immerse myself deeper in my sadhana and I could dedicate myself more to the mission of Lord Caitanya.



Deva Deva Das (HDG) (South America) 1 year

I was born in the city of Oruro, Bolivia during the month of August, 1957, in a very conservative catholic family. I attended a catholic school, were at the age of 14, I was able to enter into the school religion seminar were I studied and served for one full year.

After I read a magazine entitled Back to Godhead that a friend of mine handed to me, I concluded that I had found the goal of my life. This happened in the year 1976. My interest and curiosity was great, I wanted to know more. So, I travel to the temple of Buenos Aires in Argentina, where I stayed several days. It was a great experience.

After Buenos Aires, I was routinely travelling to the city of La Paz, the capital of Bolivia, where three devotees, among them the friend that handed me that magazine, had a small place that they called the "Temple". It was the first Hare Krishna center in Bolivia.

The next year, 1977, I joined their mission in the city of Cusco, Peru, where I took my first initiation from H.H. Hridayananda dasa Goswami in 1978. Later, after concluding my university studies in Law, and with the desire to better serve my Spiritual Master, in 1990 I moved to the United States of America where I received my second initiation in the Potomac ISKCON Temple in Maryland.

Later on, I served in different ways, doing book distribution, Pujari, cooking for the Deities and for the devotees, helping in organizing festivals and contributing toward establishing other preaching centers, cooperating with different temples and projects and also opening new Govinda Restaurants.

Currently, I am dedicated to preaching activities in the Andean Region of South America, specifically in Bolivia, Peru and Ecuador.

In different occasions in the past, I had thought about the possibility of taking the renounced order of life, but this seemed something unreachable for me. It was during an informal conversation with H.H. Jayapataka Swami, my siksa guru, when he was in the airport leaving Bolivia back in 2012, that I seriously considered his suggestion that I take the sannyasa order. This was supported by two good devotee friends of mine who are the leaders of our Bolivian Yatra.

I feel very grateful to Srila Prabhupada and my Spiritual Master. I wish that by taking the sannyasa order I will be more fit to pay this debt to them by dedicating all my efforts to this sublime process of Krishna consciousness and to the development of ISKCON.



Eklavya Das (LOK) (India/Middle East/North America) 1 year

I was born in a Jewish family in New York City in 1965. As a young child, I was interested in music and started music lessons at the age of 4. By the time I graduated from Berklee College of Music in Boston, at the age of 22, with a diploma in Recording Engineering and Production, I could play 16 different instruments.

At the age of twelve, I played the guitar in a children's production of the musical "Hair". The musical director asked me to lead the singing of:

Hare Krishna Hare Krishna

Krisna Krishna Hare Hare

Hare Rama Hare Rama

Rama Rama Hare Hare

My favorite musicians were the Beatles, especially George Harrison. I was enchanted to hear eastern philosophy and the chanting of Hare Krishna on their records.

At the age of 15, I received Bhagavad Gita As It Is. My younger sister had purchased it on the street from some devotees and offered it to me as a birthday gift. I read it occasionally, but could not make much sense of it.

While a student in Boston, I hosted a new friend who had studied Indian music in Benares, India. He introduced me to a study of Indian music. During our time together, he invited me to visit the ISKCON temple with him. I became a regular visitor there, becoming very much attached to prasadam, especially halava.

After graduation from college, I traveled around the world. I visited more than twenty-five countries as a professional musician and seeker of adventures, both material and spiritual. During this time, I received Canto One of Srimad Bhagavatam in an airport from a compassionate vaishnava. Reading the fourth verse of the Siksastakam Prayers, I felt that the flame of renunciation in my heart was kindled.

In 1991, at the age of 26, I ventured into a forest in Ireland alone. I found a solitary river valley. For one month, I ate wild stinging nettles and clover growing in the forest. Oats that I brought with me were also on the menu.

I knew I was at a crossroads in my life. I prayed to be shown my path to God. I read the Srimad Bhagavatam and I chanted Om and Hare Krishna.

My oat supply dwindled. I visited Cork, a nearby city, where I immediately met devotees again. They offered me a japa mala. I started chanting 16 rounds immediately. I moved in with them as an experiment. Within three weeks, I felt committed.

I traveled to London to the Bhaktivedanta Manor for new devotee training for three months.

Joining ISKCON Padayatra Europe, a group of devotees walking from Belfast to Moscow, I traveled by foot through Holland, Belgium, France and Spain, distributing Krishna consciousness.

In 1992, during a meeting in Spain with my spiritual master, His Holiness Lokanath Swami, I received the instruction to go to Delhi, India to assist in the preparations for the Srila Prabhupada Centennial Celebrations.

“When should I go?”, I asked him submissively.

“Tomorrow!”, was his firm reply.

I received first initiation in 1993 in Mayapur, and second initiation in 1996 in Pandharpur.

My previous services include; being the secretary for ISKCON’s Srila Prabhupada Centennial Minister, H.H. Lokanath Swami. I was also the secretary for the ISKCON India Continental Committee (ICC), and the secretary for Western India Divisional Council (WIDC).. I managed a preaching center in Solapur, Maharashtra. I was a member of the Laxmi Narasimhadev Traveling Festival in Poland. I assisted His Grace Rama Raya Prabhu in starting a daily Harinam Sankirtan program in New York City, which continues today.

I currently serve as the secretary for the GBC Deputies as well as a member of the Sannyasa Ministry Secretariat. Additional responsibilities include; a member of the GBC World Holy Name Week Committee, Chant For Change Committee and ISKCON50’s Committee for the Celebration of the 50th Anniversary of the First Kirtan in ISKCON. My primary duty is to present the Krishna conscious philosophy to a wide variety of audiences.

I have had the opportunity to visit India, North America, France, England, Spain, Belgium, Germany, Poland, Czech Republic, Switzerland, Italy, Croatia, Slovenia, Guyana, Trinidad, Russia, Mauritius, South Africa, Botswana, and the Persian Gulf, as a traveling preacher.

My current base is ISKCON Kolkata, Srila Prabhupada’s Birthplace.

In 2012, H.H. Lokanath Swami, along with several very senior ISKCON devotees, encouraged me to try to increase my service to Srila Prabhupada's movement by entering the sannyasa ashram. In pursuance of their order, I am cooperating with the Sannyasa Ministry to the best of my ability.

I was never married. I see this as a great opportunity. I feel enlivened by living on the road, and having the chance to share Krishna consciousness with a wide variety of people from different cultures. Traveling is one of the best forms of education, wherein one gets to see the lessons of the scriptures exhibited graphically. The life of a sannyasi is certainly an opportunity to travel, preach, gain realizations, and receive mercy.

By entering into the sannyasa ashram, I have faith that, by the causeless mercy of Sri Sri Guru and Gauranga, I will continue to experience acceleration in the purification of my existence and my capacity to serve.



Gopendra Das (Vrindavan, India) 4 years

I was born in Vaikunthapur village, Chattisgarh, India on 17th October, 1965 and received the name Gopal Halder. My father passed away when I was merely 6 years old. In childhood I would do Harinam Sankirtan and construct small temples out of earth with my friends and other villagers. I started my education at the age of 11 years. Due to poor financial conditions I had to work in farms to support my family and schooling.

One day a Gaudiya Vaisnava came to our village for Bhagavat Katha. After hearing his discourse I decided to renounce the world. The one day I got a book “Beyond birth and death” by Srila Prabupada which attracted me to His teachings. Then I read “Back to Godhead” where an advertisement invited young men to join ISKCON. Henceforth I finalized to join ISKCON Mayapur. Meanwhile I visited ISKCON New Delhi and had the darshans of Sri Sri Radha Parthasarathi. And on my way to Vrindavan I took the darshans of Krishna Balaram that changed my mind and I joined ISKCON Vrindavan in the year 1993.

The first 8 months were spent in new devotee training and menial services like three times temple cleaning, bathroom cleaning and prasadam service. I took first initiation in 1996 during Gaur Purnima at Mayapur from His Holiness Bhakti Charu Swami Maharaja. Then I received second initiation in April 1998 at Vrindavan. From 1994 to 1997, I did door to door book distribution with the travelling sankirtan bus. From May 1997 to March 2003 I was made the in-charge of the travelling sankirtan party.

Subsequently in April 2003, I was made assistant head pujari at Krsna Balaram Temple in Vrindavan. I participated in marathons till 2009 and distributed books while continuing my other services. I have been involved in training the brahmacharis and sankirtan devotees at ISKCON Vrindavan since 1997.

In the year 2012 I started giving discourses on Gaur Katha and visited Panipat, Sahibabad, Amritsar, Ludhiana, Panchkula, Panihati, Bhilai, Pakhanjur and Domjur in India and Dhaka, Brahmabadia, Narayanganj and Khulna in Bangladesh. Currently I am based in Vrindavan and also teaching ISKCON Guru Disciples course at various places. Now I am 51 years old and at this juncture I would like to take to the renounced order. I am sure that taking sannyasa will help me in preaching effectively and efficiently.



Govindananda Das (West Bengal, India) 5 years

I was born in a religious Brahmin family of Midnapore District in West Bengal, India. I am the younger son of my parents. I was born in a spiritual atmosphere. My father was a priest and we had Nitya Seva of Sri Sri Gour Nitai and Shaligram in our home. From very childhood I was inclined in service of Shaligram. When I was 14 years old, in 1986 during the 500th anniversary of Mahaprabhu's appearance, ISKCON padayatra travelling party was passing through our village, my father brought a copy of Back to Godhead (Bengali) and kept it in book shelf. I was unaware of that incidence.

In graduation philosophy was one of my subjects. While reading the philosophy of Sankaracharya, I understood that this material world is unreal and I decided to search for the absolute truth and to leave home.

When this desire became very keen, one day I found that magazine "Back to Godhead" in my book shelf. I saw this magazine for the first time in my book shelf although it was lying there for years. Now I realized that it was a divine arrangement of Sri Sri Gaura Nitai. I was searching for the right path and it opened up in front of me by Their Divine mercy. I got the address of Mayapur Chandrodaya temple in that magazine and immediately I decided to join ISKCON Mayapur. I received first initiation in 1992 on the holy appearance day of Srivasa Thakur and got 2nd initiation in 1994 on the appearance day of Sripad Ramanujacharya in SriDham Mayapur.

I was engaged in Book table service. After that became Book godown in-charge. After few months during the Silver jubilee of ISKCON, H.H. Bhakti Purusottam Maharaja engaged me in preaching and drama in pandal programs. Under the guidance of Maharaja I was appointed in different services namely campus

preaching, Gita study circle, Harinam preaching, cashier service etc. I served for 15 years as Harinam preaching and campus preaching departmental head. I served as school preaching departmental head for 4 years.

Later I did my schooling in Tenali (the place of famous Tenali Ram) regularly visiting the Hanuman's deity (Mukhyaprana) installed by Narahari Tirtha (No. 7 in our Guru Parampara list).

Youth

When I was just 14, the usually naughty and playful nature in me suddenly changed into a serious and philosophical one after the demise of my mother when . While studying in college (Marine Engineering) I tried to explore sense gratification under peer pressure, but found it against my nature. It was in the 3rd year of college that I heard a lecture by HG Dayaram Prabhu and made up my mind not to marry.

As I read the Gita many times and frequently heard from HH Bhakti Vidyapurna Swami at the Mayapur Gurukul, my conviction to dedicate my life for preaching the message of the Bhagavad-gita became strong.

Shastric study

While working in the Merchant Navy as an engineering officer, I utilised my abundant spare time studying Srimad Bhagavatam for hours a day. In the meantime, during my 3 months of break from my job in Shipping, I got the divine association of HG Atmatatva Das who further inspired me to study Srila Prabhupada's books and

dedicate my life for preaching and told me that life is not meant for doing some shudra work. I gave up my highly lucrative job and joined ISKCON Mira Road on Aug 20th 1997.

Initial ISKCON days

There was a great resistance from my father, who even met the Prime Minister of India asking him to tell ISKCON to give his son back. But, the divine Lotus Hand of my spiritual master, HH Gopal Krishna Goswami Maharaja on my head saved me from all calamities both from within and outside of ISKCON. Somehow my father and other family members had to settle with the harsh reality i.e. their Krishna Kiran has become a monk and it is not a circumstance nor a chance, but a prediction by a Madhva Sanyasi of Mantralaya.

As my grandmother recalls “When kiran was 7 years old, we went to Mantralayam, the divine abode of Sripad Raghavendra Swami. As a ritual we all went to meet the current swamiji of the mutt for blessings and came out only to find out that Krishna Kiran was missing. We went to look for him in swamiji’s room; there he was with the swamiji refusing to come out along with us. Swamiji told us that “he belongs to Krishna and you cannot force him into family life”.

Services done in ISKCON

As soon as I joined ISKCON Mira Road in 1997, I took up the responsibility of “New Bhakta training” and youth preaching. I got my first initiation in Jan 1998. Circumstances led me to become the Vice-president of ISKCON Mira Road in 1999. I took up congregation development and teaching in VIHE in the year 2002 after my second initiation. In 2007, I was made the President of ISKCON Mira Road, which came out to be a very strong community with a beautiful temple. I am known more for my philosophical discourses than my managerial abilities. I have also produced leaders and set up many temples and preaching centers in Vapi, Bhavnagar, Bhilwara, Udaipur, and many other places.

I have served as WIDC Vice-Chairman and have also completed the GBC College training from its first batch.

Current Services

Along with being the President of ISKCON Mira Road, I am also the member of the ILAC.

I travel extensively in South Gujarat, South Rajasthan and Panjab for preaching and guiding in setting up a standard gurukul as envisioned by Srila Prabhupada. Education is my passion; so I identify myself as teacher of Bhakti Shastri, Bhakti Vaibhav, Shad darshnas and other scriptures.

Why do I want to take sannyasa?

I feel that I am destined to be a sannyasi and I am already leading a life of a sannyasi. HH Gopal Krishna Goswami Maharaja has great expectation from me and somehow or the other I want to fulfil his desire. I just want to be a small instrument in the hands of HH Gopala Krishna Goswami Maharaja to expand Maharaja's services to Srila Prabupada.

Taking up sannyasa helps me to practice the following verse in the Srimad Bhagavatam in a more realistic way.

etam sa asthaya paratma-nistham

adhyasitam purvatamair maharsibhih

aham tarisyami duranta-param

tamo mukundanghri-nisevayaiva

I shall cross over the insurmountable ocean of nescience by being firmly fixed in the service of the lotus feet of Krsna. This was approved by the previous acaryas, who were fixed in the firm devotion to the Lord, Paramatma, the Supreme Personality of Godhead.

I took 1st Initiation on 13.08.1990 on Janmastami at ISKCON Wari Dhaka and 2nd initiation on 10.04.1992 in Ramnavami at ISKCON Rup-Sanatam Temple in Jessore, Bangladesh.

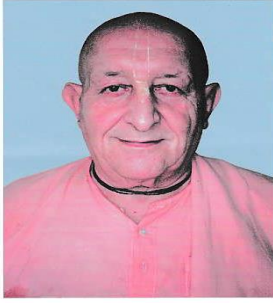
We constructed ISKCON Panthirtha Smriti Thirtha Temple at the birth place of Advithya Acharya. We bought land, then made a nice temple, where H.H. Bhakti Charu Swami, H.H. Jayapataka Swami, H.H. Subhug Swami other Maharajas and H.G. Pravavishnu Prabhu visited.

We constructed two facilities for students called BACE. One is Avaycharan BACE temple where about 65 students are cultivating in Krishna conciousness. Another one is beside Agricultural University, Sylhet. We got some land from another famous University (SUST). Now so many Namhattas and more than 10 big centres of ISKCON Sylhet Division.

I am serving as Vice President ISKCON National Council, Bangladesh Temple and President of Sri Sri Radha Madhav Jew Mandir ISKCON Sylhet. I am also taking care as a president of ISKCON Sunamgonj. ISKCON Panthitha, ISKCON Pathariya, ISKCON Duyarabazar. Divisional Secretary ISKCON Sylhet Division, Mymenshing ,Brahmanbariya, Comilla and all over Bangladesh. I am also President of Pilgrimage Development National Committee, Bangladesh.

The devotional activities I feel most enthusiastic about are Student Preaching, Kirtan also Bhajan (Baul Sanggit), Deity Worship, Congregational Preaching, Book Distribution, and Farming (Cropsfields).

I hope I will be blessed and serve them better as a sannyasa because preaching will be more.



Premadata Das (Italy/India) 2 years

I was born in Italy on 20 April, 1944. Since childhood, I received Christian education. At the age of 12, I was ready to join the Christian Seminary for becoming a Priest, but my elder brother strongly prohibited me from doing so. After military service, I completed my studies, receiving an Electro-Technician Diploma. Then I got married and became a father. After that, I joined a political-communist-extremist theatre (led by a famous Nobel-prize winning actor), as a light and sound technician and actor for four years. Then, two comrades inspired me to go to visit India. At the age of 30, in October, 1974, I entered India by road in a hippie mood, with the desire to meet a Guru with mystic powers, having read the book "Autobiography of a Yogi" (P. Yogananda). After visiting Varanasi and taking several baths in the holy river Ganga, I heard these two mantras for the first time, "HARE KRISHNA HARE KRISHNA KRISHNA KRISHNA HARE HARE, HARE RAMA HARE RAMA RAMA RAMA HARE HARE" and "OM NAMO BHAGAVATE VASUDEVAYA."

We lived under a banyan tree and I used to do spontaneous hatha yoga exercises. One day, an Italian girl met us and told us that she was living for the last two years with the same Babaji who was described in the book. We were very interested in meeting him. She gave us the address of an ashram in Gopinath bazaar in Vrindavan. After a few days, we met him and I became his follower for the next 8 months. But in Vrindavan I missed the opportunity to see Srila Prabhupad face to face, even though during the days of my stay there was also the inauguration of Krishna-Balarama Mandir. (Years later, I realized that I was not ready to meet Srila Prabhupad. I needed some training in Shaivism for destroying some quantity of ignorance, since that Babaji was in the Shaivite line.)

After one more year in India, I came back to Italy completely transformed. I was a pure vegetarian, my body weight had reduced to 64 kg from 84 kg, I was practicing hatha yoga, mantra japa (om namah shivaya), meditation, prana yoga, and after understanding the law of karma my perspective on life had changed. My wife was astonished and her love for me increased. The result was that we produced twin sons. I also started teaching Hatha Yoga and vegetarianism in many centers, and

when I opened a multipurpose center (hatha yoga, natural food, ayurvedic products, alternative books etc.), I had about 200 followers.

An ISKCON center had opened in Gallarate, just 10 km from my center, and different ISKCON devotees were visiting me and inviting me to their Sunday feast. One of them was my close friend, H.G. Goura Krishna das, and when I would visit ISKCON he used to glorify me in front of the devotees introducing me as a great yogi. I appreciated the lessons from Srimad Bhagavatam and the Prasada very much, and during my lesson of hatha yoga I used to put in the tape recorder a cassette with different Vaishnava songs like “Bhajahu re mana Sri Nanda-nandana.” In my center, I was preaching about God based on the books of famous gurus like Yogananda, Aurobindo, Sai Baba, Krishnamurti, Ramakrishna, Dalai Lama, and my Guruji Hariakandi Babaji. But one day, I had one important realization: ‘I had a very big confusion in my mind about God, about spiritual soul, about reincarnation. The philosophical explanations that the ‘big gurus’ were preaching were contradictory to each other, and it was impossible to understand who was right.’ So, one night, I was alone in my yoga center after a lesson, and I started a deep meditation. I was asking God with all my sincerity, from my heart –

“If You exist, and I think that You exist, please, please, please enlighten me about You. Who are You? Where are You? I am ready to surrender to You, but I need to know the perfect truth. Please help me!”

About a month later, H.G. Goura Krishna das invited me to attend the inauguration of the new ISKCON temple, Villa Vrindavana, near Florence in the center of Italy. It was August of 1982. I went with my family. Someone gifted me a Bhagavad Gita As It Is. As I read it, I was shocked many times and realized that God was giving me the perfect answers to my hot questions. The result was that I felt a strong desire to join ISKCON. But I had two problems to solve: 1) How could I abandon my Guruji Heriakandi Babaji? 2) What would happen to my wife (who was not favorable) and my three sons? By the mercy of Sri Krishna, two qualified devotees gave the perfect solution to my 2 problems.

1) I was in France in ISKCON Nouvelle Mayapur, and H.G. Goura Krishna das introduced me to H.G. Matsyavatara das (Srila Prabhupad disciple), telling him, “Take care of this dear friend of mine.” He took me to a nice garden, under a big tree, and asked me to narrate my history. I told him that I was attracted to join ISKCON but I could not betray by Shaivite Guruji, who was very kind to me like a father, taking care of me with love for 8 years and teaching me so many things. Very intelligently, H.G. Matsyavatara Prabhu started with great glorification of Lord Shiva,

explaining that he is the most qualified Vaishnava of the universe and therefore he can be considered the spiritual master of all Vaishnavas. Then, he asked me: "If you want to drink very pure water, where will you go to look for it?" I replied, "To the source." "Exactly. Suppose that here there is a source of water, this is Krishna. How pure will the water be 5 meters away?" I replied, "Also very pure but not 100% pure like at the source." "Exactly! Therefore, if you desire to go to the source (Krishna) to drink water, do you think that Lord Shiva will be unhappy with you? No! He will be very satisfied, because it means that he has destroyed your ignorance and was successful in your case!" This analogy was so clear, and it had the power to remove all doubts from my mind and in that moment, inside my heart, I took the decision to join ISKCON.

2) After France, we came back to Italy, Villa Vrindavana, and I was talking to H.G. Vipralamba das, head pujari. My question was, "My three young sons have the right to be taken care of by their father too, not only by their mother. And, they don't want to follow me in ISKCON. Will I not be too egoistic if for following my desire of spiritual realization I abandon them? Because, I love them. And even if now they are reluctant to follow Sri Krishna, who can help them to develop Krishna consciousness if I am not near them day after day?" He replied, "If you have the courage to abandon everything – family, property and job – for serving Sri Krishna full time with love and devotion, Lord Krishna Himself will take care of your family, property etc. And if you want all relatives to go back to Krishna, you must become a pure devotee and first you must go back to Krishna, because that was the boon given by Lord Nrsimhadeva to Prahalad Maharaj when he expressed to the Lord the desire to rescue his asura father Hiranyakasipu who had died in the lap of the Lord. The Lord said, 'From this moment, for whoever will become a pure devotee like you and come back to Goloka Vrindavana, I will automatically rescue 21 generations of relatives before and after him.'" This explanation entered my mind and my heart like a transcendental medicine and gave me the strength to give up everything and become fully dedicated to devotional service.

My first service was to oversee the bhakta program and take care of the new bhaktas. Then I associated with the sankirtan leaders and learned how to distribute lots of books and paraphernalia. I took Harinama diksha in 1983 from H.H. Bhagavan Das Maharaj, with the name Purnabrahma das. Then I became manager of the Guest House. After the exit of H.H. Bhagavan das Maharaj from ISKCON, I went for a tour to India and I married Srimati Paramakaruna Devi Dasi, very famous for her translation of Srila Prabhupad's books into Italian. At that time, I got divorced from my first wife. In Milan, my wife and I opened the ACV (Cultural Vegetarian Association) in an open space of 800 sqm where we started teaching many courses – Vegetarian kitchen, Sanskrit, Bhakti yoga, Hatha yoga, Karate, Indian dance, etc. and we had about 3000 associates and 2 other branches. We worked very hard for four years, and then we decided to permanently move to India. We started in the new

ISKCON center in Puri managed by H.G. Mayapur Chandra das. After one year, we moved to Bhubhaneshwar, Krishna Balaram Mandir, led by HH Gour Govinda Maharaj. And after his disappearance, when HH Bhaktiswarupa Damodara Swami became GBC of BBNR, we took re-initiation, both first and second, in 1997 with the new name Premadata das and Jahnava d.d.

We were engaged in the Second World Congress of Science & Spirituality in Kolkata as manager of western kitchen to look after the needs of the western delegates, full of Nobel laureates and spiritual leaders. After few months, our Guru Maharaj sent us to Tripura where I was nominated Temple President of the ISKCON temple of Agartala. The situation there was very difficult and the temple was very small and very poor. My wife, Jahnava dd was disgusted after one year and decided to go back to Puri and rejected the instruction of our Guru. I decided to remain in the position to fulfill the order of the Guru. After some time, I got divorced from Jahnava dd at the Court of Agartala. The divorce was also accepted by the Municipality of Milano where we got married fifteen years back. Without knowing well either English language or the local Bangla language, I continued my devotional service establishing all rules and regulations per the instructions of His Divine Grace Srila Prabhupada. In course of time, my English became better. I gave several hundred lessons in many parts of Tripura due to invitations from many different Mathas and Associations.

One day, an 18-year-old boy entered the temple, very agitated, and asked me to protect him from his father who was chasing him with the intention to kill him because he wanted to become a devotee of Krishna. I closed him in one room under a bed. After a few minutes, three relatives knocked on the door. When I opened the door, they enquired about the young boy. I replied that I had not seen any young boy and I showed them that all rooms were empty. They left, but the rumor attracted many local people from the side Flower Club. Their leader asked me if I needed any help. I did not understand their intention and told them that there is no need of anything. After one hour, I called the police station and they sent four policemen. I told the captain to help me protect the young man and to be very careful with him. The captain took the young man like a prisoner and they went outside very openly. The local club boys saw everything and after some time the leader of the group of boys came to me in a very angry mood, threatening me and saying, "You must go back to Italy because you are a liar and Krishna is not for you, but only for us." I replied, "Only my guru can tell me to go from here. You go to my guru and speak with him, otherwise I will not move from here. If you do not agree, you can kill me." They were surprised and ran away. But in the evening, after 9 pm, when the temple was empty of visitors, the club boys started to attack the temple, throwing many stones from outside for about one hour. And they repeated this for three nights. This happened 17 years ago. By preaching, and by distribution of Prasadam, I gradually

changed the situation and now all people there respect me and appreciate my service.

Every year, we perform Jagannath Ratha yatra in three temples simultaneously, as well as Janmastami, Gaura Purnima, and many other Vaishnava festivals, with distribution of large quantities of Prasadam. We have performed Nagar Sankirtan uncountable times, with the banner of Maha mantra and the name of ISKCON, with a speaker. Every year, I maintain transparent accounts, and we have no debts. All bills – telephone, electricity, water supply – are paid by due dates. Also, GBC fee, Bureau fee etc. are paid on time. Five years ago, at the age of 65, I received a social pension from the Italian Government and I used the entire amount of about 32,000 INR for temple purposes. And when I go to Italy for collection, making tables in different type of Fears, all profit is used for the temples and the extension centers.

Some years ago, I visited Kurukshetra and in front of the tree where Sri Krishna spoke the Bhagavad Gita to Arjuna, I took a vow to distribute one million copies of Bhagavad Gita before the end of my material body. But I am afraid of not having the capacity to maintain the vow because till now, I have distributed about 5000 B.G. only. I am 72 years old and if Sri Krishna graces me with the initiation of Sannyasa, maybe I will get the chance to distribute more and more. Finally, I beg forgiveness for all my mistakes, for all my offenses, for my laziness, for my imperfection, for my ignorance and for my stupidity and my proudness. And I thank all Vaishnavas, all ISKCON gurus and Lord Sri Krishna for permitting me to continue to be engaged in unalloyed devotional service.

Pritivardhana Das (BVPS) (Mayapur/India) 1 year

I began associating with ISKCON devotees in Prague in the winter of 1991. The next year, when I was 23 years old, I completed my MSC in Chemistry and Electronics from Institute of Chemical Technology in Prague, Czech Republic. Right after that, I traveled to Vrindavan to study Bhakti Sastri with the VIHE along with one other devotee. We travelled over land using trains and buses as a mode of transportation.

First we took a train to Istanbul, Turkey. From there we crossed over the Suez-canal to Asia and got a bus to the Iranian border. After crossing by foot we took another bus and train to reach Tehran, the Iranian capital. The train was quite comfortable, unlike the ones to come. Spending 2 days in Tehran was quite an adventure, especially the bed bugs in the hotel! Many of the Muslim people were quite intimidating, but there were a few pleasant ones who helped us to get around the city. From there we took a train to Kerman and Zahedan, where the real pearl awaited us. After waiting for 30 hours in Zahedan we set off on a Pakistani train (just for a comparison – imagine 4th class train in India) and went on a journey through the Balochistan desert in south Pakistan. Even though the ‘windows’ were firmly closed there was sand everywhere, under our clothes, inside our bags and even inside our mouths. It was very austere, but remembering that we were going to Vrindavan, we were able to tolerate it. Finally we came to Lahore. From there we crossed the Indian border to Amritsar, took a train to Delhi and at last a bus to Vrindavan.

After the VIHE courses, in October 1992, I proceeded to go on Braja Mandala Parikrama. The other devotee I came with was by this time already sitting in a plane going back to Prague. I realized however, that I did not want to go back to Europe to live a consumer life, but that I wanted to stay in Vrindavan. Afterwards, in November 1992, I took up service in Vrindavan working with Dina Bandhu Prabhu and Daivi Shakti Mataji in the mailout department for a few months.

In April 1993 I went to Mayapur to visit the Gurukula about which I had heard a lot. I had previously met H.H. Bhaktividya Purna Maharaja in 1992 in Hungary, preaching in the ISKCON temples and farms, outside universities, and homes of devotees.

I have also been conducting comprehensive seminars on Srimad Bhagavatam, Upadesamrita, and Mahaprabhu Siksastaka in Mayapur and Baroda (Gujarat) since 2012.

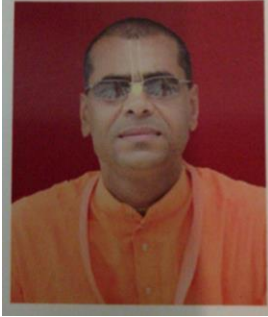
My reasons for taking Sannyasa

Hare Krishna.

My humble self was born in 1965 at Dholpur, Rajasthan. The Supreme Lord was very gracious to first give me birth in a pious Brahmin family in a simple village named Jarga. Being from a simple background not so much contaminated by the modern city life I was naturally inclined toward devotional activities from the very beginning, like sloka competition, recitations, kirtan in local temples, etc. I also had a strong inclination toward renounced order of life as I used to feel something special whenever I heard or read about the great Indian sages of yore. From as early as 1979 my life turned and somehow a strong impetus came from within to wake-up before brahma-muhurta in order to study vedic literatures. Santa Nrsimha Das (JPS) (Jaipur, India) 1 years

I was born in Lalgargh, District Midnapur in West Bengal on the 19th of February 1967. My father, Khagendranath Sahoo, was a professor in Teacher Training College in Government of West Bengal. Due to his job our family moved every three years. In that case my father enrolled me in the Ram Krishna Missionary school at Rahrha, near Kolkata. There I studied till tenth class after which I joined Howrah Shivpur College and completed BSC graduation.

After my education I took employment in the Revenue Department of the Government of West Bengal. I worked there for three years before I joined ISKCON in Mayapur in 1992. Devotees of Mayapur Sankirtan book bus were distributing books in my office and playing Srila Prabhupada's kirtan. I was very attracted to this sound and saw so many books like Caitanya Caritamrita, I was most impressed. In the Bhagavad Gita I saw Srila Prabhupada's signature and I thought, this was many different persons names. The devotee then told me all about Srila Prabhupada and I was even more attracted. The devotee came again in the lunch hour and I helped him sell three sets of Caitanya Caritamrita.

I later took a set of CC myself and read the whole CC set before reading Bhagavad Gita. After that I came to Mayapur with my parents for a visit. At that time one devotee from that same book bus took me to Murari Gupta, head of new bhakta program. He preached to me for 2 hours and asked me to join. He told me that, as your family is stable why do job, you should come and join and serve Srila Prabhupada's mission. That same year without telling my family, late one night, I came to Mayapur and next day joined fulltime in 1992.

After completion of new devotee training program I was given the service of maintaining accounts in Sankirtan Department. After serving there for one year Jayapataka Swami agreed to give me first initiation during the Gaurpurnima Festival 1994 and gave me the name Santanrsimha Das. I was then given the service of book distribution on travelling sankirtan party. After my first preaching tour which lasted around 45 days I was made group leader of one of the Sankirtan groups for the next preaching tour. I served in this position from 1994 to 2000 and during this period HH Jayapataka Swami gave me second initiation in 1999 Gaurpurnima. In 2000 I was put in charge of three Sankirtan groups and from 2003 I was put in charge of all ten Sankirtan book distribution parties, until 2007. In this service I was

feeling very good and I realised that, to maintain brahmacari life this service was best for me. In this period of travelling Sankirtan I was able to read Srila Prabhupada's Srimad Bhagavatam fully, sometimes reading until late night. Slowly I was attracted to studying Srila Prabhupada's books more and more and whenever I was in Mayapur I would attend all seminars and classes.

In 1999 I had completed Bhakti Sastri course and in 2004 I completed TTC1, TTC2 and BSTTC. From 2004 to 2007 I taught Bhakti Sastri in Mayapur and Bangladesh in Bengali language. While at the same time I continued in my service as Travelling Sankirtan leader.

In 2007 I came to Vrndavan then Jaipur on pilgrimage, at that time Pancaratna Prabhu, Temple President in Jaipur, requested me to stay here and preach in Hindi language, as there a great shortage of good Hindi preachers. I then started serving as congregational preacher and part time pujari. In 2009 I went to Pune for Youth Preaching Training course after which I started to organise Youth Preaching programs in Jaipur.

Presently under my direction many Bhakti Vriskha groups are going on, Bhakti Sastri classes in Temple and soon we will develop a Youth Bace group in the Temple. In Jaipur I am developing Congregational Preaching and we have reached out with three extension centers in Chomu, Udaipur and Ajmer. The Chomu center is very strong with 60 congregational devotees doing Harinam Sankirtan every day. In 2011, with the permission of the ISKCON Board of Examination, we started Bhakti Sastri Courses in Hindi. I have been teaching Bhakti Sastri since then. Along with this service I am also serving as Co-Vice President in ISKCON Jaipur and also the Temple Head Pujai. Presently Sri Sri Giridari Dauji are installed in Jaipur and in this year, 2016, we will be installing Sri Sri Gaur Nitai and Sri Sri Radha Madhan Gopal.

Sundarlala Das (Mauritius) 2 years

I was born on 17th September 1965, the exact date when Srila Prabhupada landed in USA. I was raised in a very strict family. As a young man I was very much attracted to sports, music and arts. The sports were most importantly to promote a sense of good health. Volley ball was my favourite game. I have learned the basics practice of good sportsmanship from my second brother Vinod. He was very keen and wanted me to make progress in my sports and educational careers. As a figurehead of sport organisation, I was always surrounded by a circle of friends who would visit me daily to prepare for tournaments. In 1982 I became a member of a newly born Literary Club. It was called VARD which meant Voluntary Agency for Rural Development. The aim of this club was to educate and help individuals, families, communities to enhance their individual and collective well being, and help to bring social change, cohesion and to make infrastructural development in rural areas. During my youth I had many questions that were haunting me which are as follows. Who is the creator? Who created the creator? Who decides who should be the God? Why someone specific? Why not somebody else? Is this world real or is it fake? Are those people I see around me real or are they just puppet show or are they made only for my pleasure? How are the moon and the stars created? VARD did not really give me satisfactory answers to all my quests. During my school years I was attracted by a school girl who happened to be a Hare Krishna devotee. In my search for this girl I end up to become a lover of Krishna Consciousness. In fact our first meeting never took place because most probably I was not confident enough. Lord Krishna explains four types of people approach Him. So this was just bait on a hook. In the same year I was invited by my best friend to attend a huge Hare Krishna Hall program which was attended by a thousand guests. At the end of the lecture the speaker would ask is there any questions or comments? The questions and answers sessions were my favourite part of the program. I did not want to become a blind follower. So after two or three programs which I had attended I started to stab the devotees with a volley of questions.

In a very short time my questions and doubts were cleared by the expert explanation of the devotees which took me to the next level of reading Srila Prabhupada's books and Back to Godhead magazines. Srila Prabhupada's books contain the highest understanding of not only how to become a worshipper of God or to know who the creator of the creator is but to become a lover of God. This is the

unique contribution of Srila Prabhupada's books. It is beyond the jurisdiction of ritualistic ceremonies as practiced by almost every Hindu. 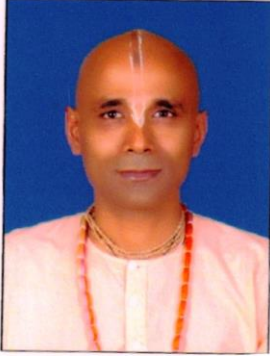

From 2004 till now, I serve as the Leader of Bhakti-shastri Office and Bhakti-shastri teacher in Baltics.

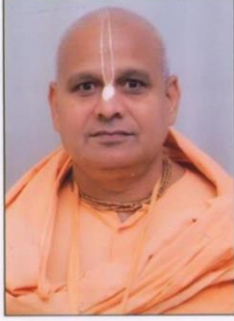
From 2007-2008, I was the Chairman of Temple meeting in Tallinn (Estonia).

Vrindavanchandra Das (Vrindavan, India) 1 years

I was born on January 2nd, 1963 in a village Gurura in the Bihar Province of India. In 1977, when I was studying in high school, one of my classmate (now Raghunath Das) invited me to visit Vrindavan along with him. I was unwilling but he persisted and finally I agreed and another senior schoolmate also joined us. I had no money for travel and other required expenses. I managed Rs 50 from my scholarship account but that was insufficient. Next task was to get parent's permission, which I didn't have the courage to ask my father so I approached my mother. At first, she refused completely but after my persistent requests she complied with the condition that I should return soon and she provided me some money as well and we started our journey to Vrindavan.

After reaching Mathura, we enquired from the local sadhus about how to go to Vrindavan but they directed us to go to Barasana as it was a festival day of Holi and everyone was headed towards Barasana. From there, we came to Goverdhan and stayed at Kaladhari Ashram for one night. Next day after darshan and parikrama, we came to Radhakunda and walked all the way to Vrindavan as there was no conveyance available.

Once we reached ISKCON Vrindavan, we met HH Radha Govinda Maharaj and felt much relieved. We were allowed to stay in Brahmachari Ashram and were engaged in temple cleaning services. Srila Prabhupad was expected to arrive in Vrindavan but due to his ill health, the visit was cancelled. After a few weeks, we returned back to our village. After a few months, I received a message that Srila Prabhupada was in Vrindavan. I travelled again to Vrindavan and got the opportunity to meet Srila Prabhupad in the month of June. After spending a week, I returned back to my village.

After a few months, HH Radha Govinda Maharaja visited our village for Bhagavat Katha and stayed there for a few days. During this period, we received the news of

Srila Prabhupad's disappearance from this world in Vrindavan through a local newspaper. It was a big shock.

Next month, I received the first initiation from HH Radha Govinda Maharaja on December 21st, 1977 on the auspicious occasion of Gita Jayanti.

Next year, I accompanied Guru Maharaja along with Vrindavan Temple President on a Book Distribution Tour. After that I was sent to Delhi temple for book distribution services under the guidance of HH Lokanath Maharaja. There I got the opportunity to visit Sridham Mayapur in 1979.

I had to join Banaras Hindu University (BHU) due to parent's pressure. There we organized several preaching programs. Our guru maharaja also visited BHU to conduct lectures on Bhagavad Gita. After that I went to my village and received 2nd initiation on 28th January, 1981. After a couple of years, I started to assist Guru Maharaja in preaching activities in Bihar. During this period, my primary service was to organize and develop Namhatta Centers in Bihar.

Gradually, a strong desire developed in my heart to spend more time in Vrindavan, so after Silver Jubilee Celebration of Krishna Balaram Temple, I started to live in Vrindavan with Guru Maharaja. Several temples started to invite me for Satsanga Programs in Hindi. In this way, I remained engaged in conducting seminars and Kathas in Hindi. Once Namhatta department opened in Vrindavan, I got engaged for the same services here as well.

In 2012, I completed my Bhakti Sastri Course. Since 2013, I am being given assignment for teaching Bhakti Shastri Course at VIHE. Currently, I stay in Vrindavan, and continue to preach in Namhatta Programs and teach at VIHE. On certain occasions, I am invited to conduct classes in the other parts of the state such as Jhansi, Agra, Shahibabad and also Bihar and Mauritius.
